

1. 次の文は、ギブ・キッズ・ザ・ワールド( Give Kids The World )についての話である。  
英文を読んで、あとの問いに答えよ。

Do you know the “Give Kids The World” program? This program was made for sick children. Sick children can visit Disneyworld, Sea World and Universal Studio thanks to this program. In 1986, “Give Kids The World” built a very large hotel for sick children called “Give Kids The World Village.” This hotel has about 100 large rooms. “Give Kids The World” gives sick children and their families rooms and food for free. Then Florida theme parks like Disneyworld, Sea World and Universal Studio give them tickets for free. They don’t have to pay money. Now, many sick children can have a great trip to theme parks before they die. Why was this program started?

This program was made by Henri Landwirth. He was born in Europe, in 1927. When World War II started, he was taken to a Nazi-death-camp. His parents died, but he didn't. After the war, Henri worked very hard to get to America. When he came to New York, he couldn't speak English very well and had only \$20. He started working at hotels, and after many years he became the manager of some important hotels in Florida.

When he was a manager in Florida, a little girl named Amy wrote him a letter. She had leukemia and had only one wish. She wanted to go to Disneyworld before she died. Henri said she could stay his hotel for free, but Amy died and couldn’t go to Disneyworld. This made Henri very sad, and he decided to help children like Amy through his life. Amy’s last wish was to go to a theme park. Henri thought that taking sick children to a theme park was a good idea because sick children should enjoy their life like other children. So, he started “Give Kids The World.” Today, “Give Kids The World ”program has helped about 90,000 families from over 65 countries.

People working at “Give Kids The World” are all volunteers. They give their time and work to the program. They are happy to help for free. Volunteers support “Give Kids The World.” The volunteers say, “We don’t do it only for the children. We do it for ourselves, because children’s happy faces make us happy and our lives better.”
